2007 Huronia Communities Foundation “Circle of Honour” Philanthropy Awards

“Circle of Honour” Business Award

Focus:

This Award is to be presented in recognition of a Huronia Community business that has demonstrated outstanding financial support and community involvement in philanthropic causes. Motivation of others to take leadership roles will also be recognized.

“Circle of Honour” Philanthropic Group Award

Focus:

This Award is to be presented in recognition of a Huronia Community Service Club, Religious Organization, Not-for-profit Organization or Granting Foundation that has demonstrated outstanding commitment through financial support and through encouragement and motivation of others to take leadership roles toward local philanthropy.

“Circle of Honour” Individual Award

Focus:

This Award is to be presented in recognition of a Huronia Community individual philanthropist for his/her exceptional commitment to the advancement of philanthropy and skills in coordinating and motivating groups of volunteers for fundraising projects for the benefit of local charitable causes.

“Circle of Honour” Youth in Philanthropy Award

Focus:

This Award is to be presented in recognition of outstanding leadership in philanthropy on the part of a Huronia Community youth (5 –18 years of age) or a college or university student. This Award will foster the next generation of philanthropic leaders and will help to broaden public awareness of the value of philanthropy.

Eligibility and Nomination Criteria

Any member of the Huronia community may submit a nomination for this Award. The nomination should include the following information with specific examples that provide:

1. Evidence of philanthropic support and innovative approaches in the Huronia community for solving charitable needs on a continuing basis.
2. Description of gift support (financial contribution) and achievements accomplished through your giving efforts.
3. Evidence of encouragement and motivation given to others to take leadership roles towards philanthropy and community involvement.
4. Visual documentation of participation and contributions (photos, press releases or videos, etc) that may be used to highlight contributions of the Award recipients at Annual Gala.

Submission Criteria

- Nominators must produce a Nomination Document (maximum 4 pages).
- Not more than six attachments (cover letters, letters of support, press clippings, etc) will be considered as part of the evaluation process.

The "Circle of Honour" Awards Selection Committee will review candidates based on the eligibility criteria set out above. If in the judgment of the Committee, in any given year, no applications meet the criteria, no Award will be given in this category.
